- * Tutorial video links on the use of MS Teams and trouble shooting for

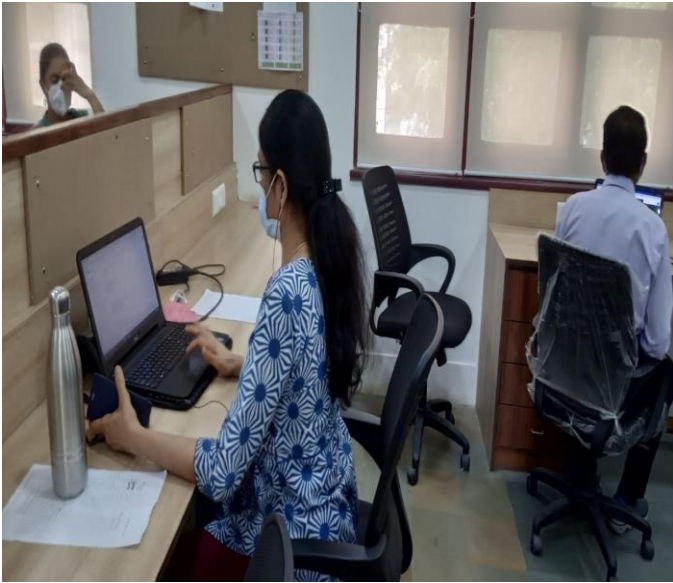
MS Teams platform has been circulated in our WhatsApp groups created for Regular & Visiting faculty.
